A – Virtual Meetings

We may also set up meetings via "Zoom" to discuss your project more in-depth.

B – In-Person Meetings

If you would like for us to come out, we always sanitize our hands before arriving at your house and we will respect the 6' Rule as designated by the CDC. If you're living in the home, you should wipe down any surfaces that we might have come in contact with, but we typically do not need to touch anything. If the house is empty, we keep sanitizers in our vehicles. We will not schedule a visit if any of us have any symptoms at all and we ask the same of you.
